## **Consider these facts**

about the wood used in paper production:

**More Forests Exist Today:** 12 million more acres of forest exist in the U.S. today than 20 years ago.<sup>1</sup>

**More Trees are Standing Today:** 49% increase between 1953 and 2006 in the number of trees still standing after mortality and harvesting.<sup>2</sup>

**More Trees are Planted Daily:** 1.7 million trees are planted every day by the U.S. paper and forest products industry; <sup>3</sup> and 600 million annually worldwide.<sup>4</sup>

**Fiber Content is Tracked:** FSC<sup>5</sup> and SFI<sup>6</sup> track fiber content from certified lands through production and manufacturing to the end product. There are certified forests in over 80 countries.<sup>7</sup>

**Fiber Sources Must Be Declared:** The Lacey Act of 2008 states that a declaration must be made by the importer of paper to assure that paper did not come from illegally sourced fiber.
