Recyclable



Consider these facts

about how print is recycled and reused:

Recycled Daily: 87% of Americans have access to curbside or drop-off paper recycling programs¹ and 63.5% of all paper consumed in the United States was recovered for recycling in 2010.²

Recovered by Paper Mills: 115 paper mills in the United States used recovered fiber exclusively in 2010, and 289 more, or 77%, used at least some recovered material in their manufacturing process.³

Reused in Construction Products: 1.6 million tons of construction products were made in 2010 from paper, including gypsum wallboard and sound-absorbing materials.⁴

Reused in Consumer Products: 5,000 non-construction products are made from recycled paper, including masking tape, bandages, hospital gowns, coffee filters, car insulation, lamp shades and egg cartons.⁵
