# What you need to know

about the environmental impact of print on paper:



- **Responsible:** 90% of the paper consumed in the U.S. is produced in the U.S.<sup>[1]</sup>



- **Renewable:** 90% of the wood harvested in the U.S. comes from private “tree farms.”<sup>[2]</sup>



- **Recyclable:** 63.5% of the paper consumed in the U.S. was recycled in 2010.<sup>[3]</sup>
